Hoisington is a VFW Gold Legacy Life member who also helped sign the charter for the new VFW Post 12228 in Stanwood, Washington, and attended the VFW Department Convention with Dodger this summer.

Hoisington gives Dodger all the credit for enabling him to continue serving and give back to the community.

"I now have something meaningful in my life, and it makes me want to help other veterans," he said.
