

VFW Kicks Off Inaugural Day of Service

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — Starting this Saturday, communities across America and around the world will feel the support of our nation's veterans like never before as the VFW kicks off its inaugural Day of Service.

Hundreds of VFW Posts will commence the initiative on May 7 by hosting veteran-led events aimed to engage veterans, service members and community advocates while making a meaningful difference in their communities. Events will continue through Memorial Day.

The VFW Day of Service is an outgrowth of the organization's #StillServing campaign launched in 2020 to recognize the ongoing dedication of veterans and service members who continue to serve their communities. VFW members log more than 3 million community service hours annually.
